NEW TRANSFORMER INSTALLATION

Receiving Inspections

- Comprehensive inspection performed at rail siding, port of entry, substation site or wherever the transformer is located

Complete Assembly

- Install all parts removed for shipment to make the transformer operational

Oil Handling

- Lower oil level to install bushings or other parts (if the unit was shipped oil-filled)
- SPX Transformer Solutions' oil tank trucks available for on-site oil storage or hauling

Vacuum Degasify / Prep New Oil / Vacuum Oil-Filling Process

- SPX Transformer Solutions' oil processing equipment can vacuum degasify and get new oil ready for installation, pull vacuum on the transformer and complete the vacuum oil-filling process using customer specifications, the transformer supplier's specifications or our specifications



Testing

- Complete a full range of tests to verify the new or relocated unit is ready for service



TRANSFORMER RELOCATIONS

Disassembly

- Perform any disassembly work necessary for units to be safely moved
- Package parts for shipment and load on truck, railcar, etc.

Rigging and Hauling

- Take total responsibility for getting equipment from one location to another, including hiring and coordinating with rigger and heavy hauler to load, move and unload unit onto customer foundation

Assembly and Oil Handling / Processing

- Reassemble parts removed for shipment
- Remove, transport and process oil
